#### **Trash Catastrophe**

#### Operation: Go Green...A Bad Day for Plastic

Mrs. Sara's 5<sup>th</sup> grade class has been working on their "Go Green" project for the past year. Our goal was to help our school (and eventually district) reduce single use plastics and create less waste. We started off by doing a trash audit (a sort of which we separate the main waste items people used and then we collect the date). We decided to replace our plastic spork packs with compostable birchbark sporks. We also stopped just giving everyone the sport pack, instead students can just take a napkin or a spork it they need one. Thanks to your help we have made a huge impact so far. We have reduced our use of all single use plastics!!! We also raised \$800 during our Chico Bag Fundraiser (THANK YOU FAMILIES!!!); this will allow us to continue to be able to purchase the new sporks. This past weekend, six students: Julia Marin, Nicholas Barrett, Sam Chitwood, Tatiana Brantley, Kattie Cramblet and Ashton Turner represented Mar Vista at the Monterey Bay Aquarium's Ocean Plastic Pollution Summit! I am very proud of all the hard work that our students have done. We have been working very hard to make our school and world environmentally friendly place. Now the kids are learning how to refuse (say NO to single use plastic and other items you don't need to use) reuse and recycle our school is staying clean and using less. Thanks to your help and support we have made a huge impact so!
