Dear Mar Vista Families

How you start the school year can determine how well the rest of the year will go. Here is how to make sure your child gets off to a great start this year:

- Review school safety. Talk to your child about the importance of following school rules. The Code of Conduct at Mar Vista School is Be Safe, Be Respectful, and Be Responsible.
- Get to know your child's teacher. When parents and teachers are on the same team, kids do better in school. Once you've met face to face, you'll find it easier to ask questions or share a concern about your child. Set goals. Students who do best in school have both short and long term goals. Whether it's earning high marks in math, your child needs goals to keep them on the right track.
- Settle into a routine. Kids thrive on predictability. Have a regular time for homework. Set and stick to a regular bedtime. Plan a morning routine that gets everyone out the door on time.
- Don't over schedule your child. Give them time to unwind after school.
- Be interested in your child's schoolwork. Ask them about school every day.

This program is differentiated to your specific student's skill level. The program is designed for Kinder through 5th grade. In addition to Lexia, the students can take AR quizzes; work on math facts, Manga High (math), Starfall, Dance mat typing, and word processing. Take advantage of this excellent resource. This program is available for all grades. The additional 30 minutes of daily practice is well worth it and may be just what your student needs to push them forward academically.

Harvest Festival!


